## Be a Part of the Mahaiwe




In 2005, a century after the Vaudeville-era Mahaiwe Theater was constructed, the curtain rose on the Mahaiwe Performing Arts Center. Lovingly restored – including reconstruction of the original 1930s marquee, a Great Barrington landmark – the theater is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places.

Today, the Mahaiwe is a non-profit, year-round presenter of world-class music, from Broadway and Rock to Bluegrass and Jazz, as well as dance, drama, comedy, classic films, and HD broadcasts from the National Theatre of London and the Metropolitan Opera. Hundreds of the nation's most sought-after performers have graced the Mahaiwe stage, and the Mahaiwe's community engagement and performing arts education programs reach thousands of families and students throughout the Berkshire region.
